Vocational Scholarships

Career Tech Education Scholarships for Greater Spokane Valley Students

Students applying for two-year vocational and trade school programs have opportunities for financial support through the Spokane Valley Chamber Foundation. A combined need-based and merit-based scholarship program has been cultivated to support students pursuing their 2-yr. education in the Greater Spokane Valley region.

The scholarship is open to high school seniors and prior graduates of Spokane Valley high schools who are pursuing a degree or certificate in a trade locally. Students who attended the following school districts are eligible: Spokane Valley Tech, Central Valley, East Valley, West Valley and Freeman. Scholarships vary, up to \$3,000 annually, which can be used for tuition, fees and the cost of any tools/equipment needed for their program. College Scholarships

Sam Campbell Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was created through memorial gifts given to honor a former Spokane Valley business leader. The original gifts are growing in a specially designated investment fund. Each year a \$1,000 scholarship is given to a local graduating high school student who wishes to pursue studies toward a degree in business or a business-related major.

In the past several years, this scholarship has helped students progress toward earning degrees in business administration, sports management, hotel and restaurant management and accounting, among others.

The 2017 winner was Patricia Alvaro, who is attending Gonzaga University.
