Career Tech Education Scholarships for Greater Spokane Valley Students

Students applying for two-year vocational and trade school programs have opportunities for financial support through the Spokane Valley Chamber Foundation. A combined need-based and merit-based scholarship program has been cultivated to support students pursuing their 2-yr. education in the Greater Spokane Valley region.

The scholarship is open to high school seniors and prior graduates of Spokane Valley high schools who are pursuing a degree or certificate in a trade locally. Students who attended the following school districts are eligible: Spokane Valley Tech, Central Valley, East Valley, West Valley and Freeman. Scholarships vary, up to \$4,500 annually, which can be used for tuition, fees and the cost of any tools/equipment needed for their program. Students can apply at: spokanevalleychamber.org
